# Unifi Controller

## Local and remote accounts

A local account is a combination of a username and password, and can only be used on the internal network (accessing the Unifi Controller's IP address directly.)

A remote account consists of an email and a password, and enables one to access the network from somewhere else (say, if you are visiting your family for a week and need to do some tweaking.) One would then access the Unifi dashboard via <https://unifi.ui.com/>

It is possible for an account to be both, which is the case for our root account, **network**, which is also accessible remotely via the [network@amaravati.org](mailto:network@amaravati.org) email account.

Make sure remote accounts have 2 Step Verification enabled. At present, [network@amaravati.org](mailto:network@amaravati.org) can generate codes either via email, or using the Google Authenticator app on the IT Admin's smartphone.
