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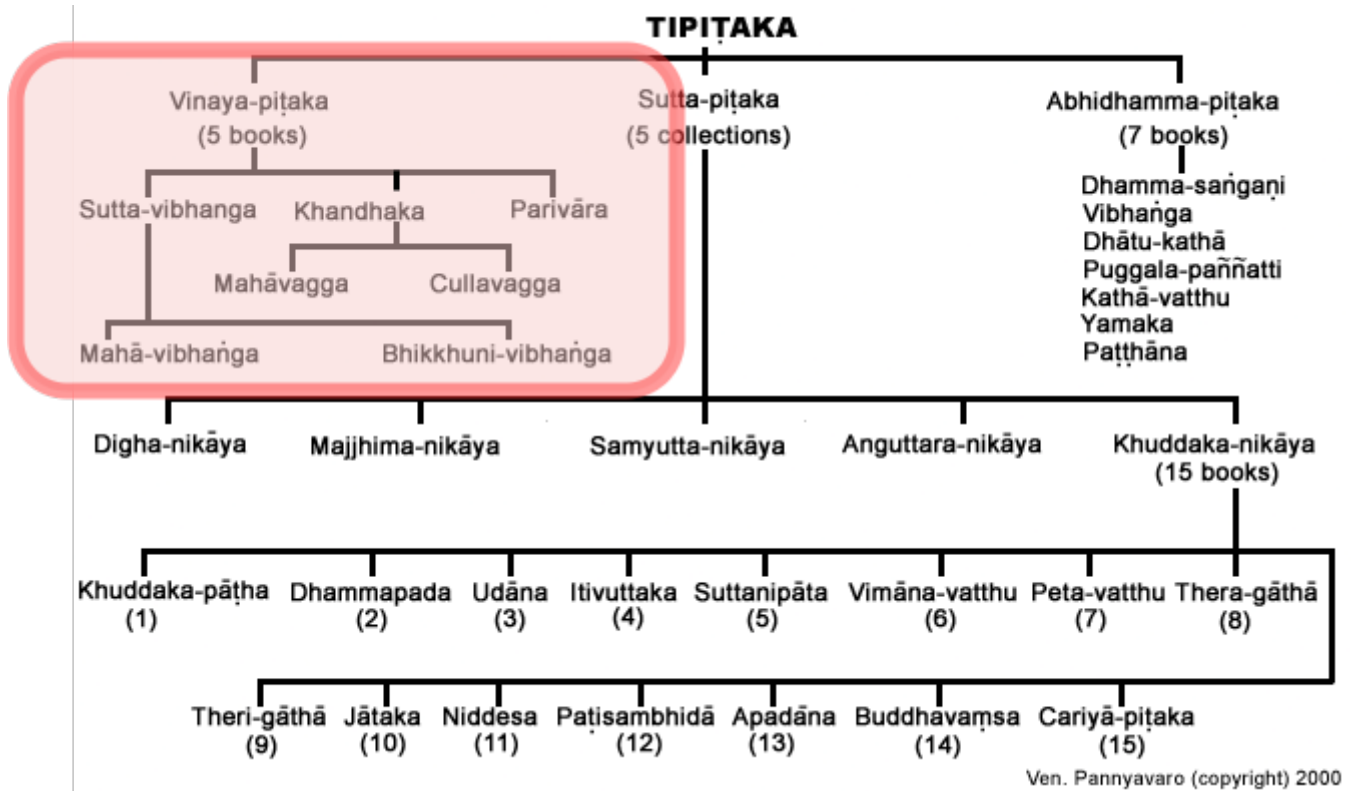

Vinaya Pitaka

The first section of the Tipitaka is the Vinaya Pitaka composed of 3 main sections



Definitions of the Vinaya books:

- **Suttavibhaṅga:** Pāṭimokkha and analysis
 - **Mahāvibhaṅga:** rules for monks
 - **Bhikkhunīvibhaṅga:** rules for nuns
- **Khandhaka:** 22 chapters on various topics
 - **Mahāvagga:** Great Division
 - **Cullavagga:** Minor Division
- **Parivāra:** analyses of rules from various points of view

Vinaya Mukha, Somdet Phra Mahā Samaṇa Chao (1st Ed. in 1916) A guide to the Vinaya written in Thai, first English edition published in 1969. It is still used as the official textbook on Vinaya for the examinations run by the Thai Council of Elders, and taken as authoritative through much of Thailand.
