One time Job

Windows

- **Dripline**
- **Overhang protector/rain cover/flashing** (metal)
 - Roof corner flashing
 - *Abutment flashings can be used to flash the top of lean-to roofs to ensure a watertight finish, and can also be used where roofs meet walls. They provide the same functionality as a standard barge board but the painted finish is on the internal angle.*
- **Trim Board (outside architrave)**
 - Oil based Primer
 - **Brown Demidekk paint**
- **Handle** for main window
- **L braces**
- **Fill gap with Foam**

Roof

- **Soffit & Facials**
 - Oil Primer
 - Green Demidekk Paint
- **Batten**
 - Cladding 25 x 35 mm
 - 7x battens, 40 cm apart approximately
 - Start on edges
 - Arc < 2.5 m
- **Barge Board** (fascias located at the gable end or side of a roof)

- Add 2x4 on top of the other one
- Fix with battens using offcuts
- Add extra piece at the ends
- Oil Primer
- Green Demidekk Paint

Walls

- **Batten**
 - Cladding 19 x 35 mm.
- **Cladding**
 - 6 cm gap (10 cm under plank) in between
 - **Plane** outside no more than 1mm
- **Trim around windows**

Interiors

- **Ceiling + ply paint white**
 - Wood Filler (2 parts) gaps & nails
 - Caulking for large cracks and screw holes on visible wood in porch
 - Primer (2 coats)
 - White (2 coats)
- **MDF Walls**
 - Nails with Punch
 - Honey Dew Paint
- **Skirting** Board - nail to the wall, paint white
- **Mouldings** (scarf joint away from door), paint Honeydew
- **Architrave** (frame with mouldings around a door or window), paint white
- **Double Door**
 - Frame
 - Door Stop strip
 - Handle + Lock
 - Sanding (use steel wool for cleaning first)
 - Apply mahogany stain lightly, one or two coats.
- **Bamboo Floor**
- **Decking, leave untreated**
- **Buddha Shelf**
- **Inside platform (bed)**
 - Higher than a chair ?

Update April 4th

1. **Clean** and **level** all the shelves and table in the new workshop
 1. The metal section table could ideally be levelled under the window seal.
2. **Move** maybe one or two more stainless steel tables to the paint store. (I thought that the one in the RC container might be too big, but actually, it could work well. To be tested.
3. **Building shelves** and **coat hanger** in open garage. (need to buy more rails for our brackets, needs research, Eleonora might help)
4. Move or dispose pile outside workshop to furniture store.
5. **Denailing** wood scrap and fill out the trailer (when it is hooked to the shogun)
6. adjusting **Stoppers** on the hanging power plug so that they don't go up to the ceiling in the new workshop

To-do list after the WR 2025

1. **Install** outdoor wood sign
 1. Back kitchen door, next to flower shed : **KITCHEN**
 2. 3 parking spaces opposite to flower shed : **PARKING**
 3. **GARDEN SHED**
 4. Workshop left door (divert traffic from offices) : **WORKSHOP**
 5. In the second gate of the monastery, viewing from outside: **NO ENTRY**
2. **Paint** the side faces of the outdoor arrow signs black (opposite to the arrow end)
